Dear Member:

The Manitoba Orff Chapter will once again be sponsoring Children's Day on Friday, April 27<sup>th</sup>, 2012. This year, we invite you to select grade 5 students from your school to participate in this fantastic professional development opportunity and event. This fun-filled and musically enriching day will take place at the Centre culturel franco-manitobain (340 Provencher Blvd) from 8:30am to 3:30pm.

This year we will be featuring five excellent clinicians. Under the leadership of these expert clinicians, students will take part in various workshops integrating choral singing, recorder, movement, and ensemble playing on the Orff instruments. The day's activities will culminate in a sharing session presented by all participating students, which parents and administrators are welcome to attend. The chosen theme is "Whatever the Weather" – students will explore the weather in a fun, musical, Orff-based way!

Please use the following guidelines when selecting students to participate:

- Select up to 10% of the school's grade 5 enrollment (maximum of 4 and minimum of 2). More spots may be granted only after the deadline and at the discretion of the registrar.
- Students must be proficient and comfortable in the five areas of the Orff process (singing, movement, speech, improvisation and instrumental playing, including soprano recorder).
- Students must have a positive attitude, be willing to take creative risks, and be responsible.
- Students should be accompanied by a teacher/parent, if possible.

Please note that you must be a member of the Manitoba Orff Chapter in order to enroll your students in this event. If you have any questions about membership or wish to become a member, please contact the MOC membership secretary, Jody Craigen, at [Membership@manitobaorff.org](mailto:Membership@manitobaorff.org). \*Teachers and adult/parent accompanying their child are admitted gratis. \*Teachers without participating students who wish to observe must pay \$20.00. Please indicate if a student teacher will be attending. The fee per student teacher attending is \$10.00.

Students will be accepted on a first-come first-served basis. The fee is \$20.00 per student. Enclosed you will find a registration form, teacher overview sheet, and covering letter for parents. Please make as many copies as necessary. Deadline for student application is March 16, 2012. Any registration forms sent without fees cannot be accepted. Note to teachers: If your school is paying for your students, you may white out the line about "cheque payable" on registration form.

- The day's activities will culminate in a sharing session presented by the participating students. Family and friends are welcome to attend this session, which will begin at 3:00 p.m.
- The day will end at 3:30 p.m. Please arrange for your child to be picked up at that time. There will be no supervision of students after 3:45 p.m.
