



THE MORNA-JUNE MORROW AWARD FOR EXCELLENCE IN MUSIC EDUCATION IN MANITOBA

To qualify for the Morna-June Morrow Award for Excellence in Music Education in Manitoba, all nominees (and sponsors) must be current members of the Manitoba Orff Chapter, and meet at least 4 of the 6 criteria listed below.

Criteria:

1. Music teacher in a public or private school or institution.
2. Actively using Orff methodology in the music class setting.
3. Actively involved in church and/or community music-related activities.
4. Self-initiating in his/her professional development.
5. Strong sense of dedication and organizational skills.
6. Actively involved with a music-related board/executive (ie: MOC, MMEA, MCA, etc.)

The award nomination should include the following:

- * sponsor's name and affiliation to Nominee (must not be a parent of a student)
- * information concerning Nominee
- * teaching experience of Nominee (ie: position, location, years of experience)
- * Nominee's contribution to the profession including school program, extracurricular activities, community involvement, professional development, and involvement in workshops/in-services
- * publication and recognition awards received by Nominee
- * rationale for nomination
- * signatures of both the sponsor and the Nominee
