

MANITOBA ORFF CHAPTER RESOURCES LIBRARY

The Manitoba Orff Chapter Resources Library was established in July 1994 with materials owned by the late HELEN NEUFELD, a Past President of the Manitoba Orff Chapter, and given by her family to the Orff Chapter. In July 1996, DOREEN HALL, who brought the Orff-Schulwerk concept to North America, donated over 200 books and music to the Resources Library. Upon her retirement in 1998, MORNA-JUNE MORROW, Founding President of the Manitoba Orff Chapter and a Past President of Carl Orff Canada, donated a further 500 books, music and recordings. Other donations have been received over the years from individuals and the Chapter itself.

Since its inception in 1994, Morna-June Morrow has acted as Facilitator of the Manitoba Orff Chapter Resources Library. During this sixth revision, she totally re-catalogued the entire Resources Library into various categories using a series of **CODES WITH LETTERS AND NUMBERS**. (Bracketed numbers indicate the number of copies available.)
